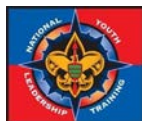

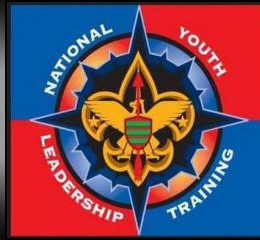

## Who can attend NYLT?

NYLT is a co-educational course for Boy Scouts and Venture Scouts who meet the following requirements by the beginning of the course:

- Be between 13-17 years old as a Boy Scout
- Be between 14-20 years old as a Venture Scout
- Be a First Class Scout or higher.
- Have taken *Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops* or
- Have taken *Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews*
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law or Venturing Oath and Code
- Be a youth who is on track for a leadership position and will bring these skills back to his/her unit
- He/she must want to attend NYLT and have enthusiasm and desire to participate in this intense learning experience!

## What is the purpose of NYLT?

- To support the role of the Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor in training junior leaders
- To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the troop program
- To give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experiences with Scouts and Venturers from other units
- To create an atmosphere where Scouts will experience Scouting at its best
- To enhance the relationship between the participant and his or her adult leaders
- NYLT is not designed to improve poor conduct or behavior-it is designed to build leadership skills in Scouts who already possess the foundations of those skills in his or her daily life*
