All Scouts can attend Read either with their troop or by themselves as an individual camper. If attending with your troop - your fee of \$345 per week will be paid to your troop. If attending as an individual camper, please download the individual camper registration form at wpcbsa.org/Read and submit payment of \$385 per week to the Council Service Center in Hawthorne.
